# **Articulation Agreement**

## Between

# Macomb ISD and Macomb Counties state approved CTE Programs

## And

# **Davenport University**

Articulation is a method of granting university-level course credit for learning and skills accomplished as part of secondary school instruction. The Macomb ISD and Macomb Counties state approved CTE Programs and Davenport University will maintain the integrity of their separate programs and enter into this agreement as cooperating educational institutions.

## Student Qualifications

- 1. The student must have successfully completed the secondary school state approved CTE program with a grade of 3.00 (on a 4.00 scale) or better.
- 2. The student must have graduated from secondary school no more than 27 months prior to enrollment at Davenport University.

### Procedure

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- 1. The student indicates to the Macomb ISD and Macomb Counties state approved CTE Programs instructor that he or she is interested in articulating the secondary school state approved CTE program for credit at Davenport University.
- 2. The Macomb ISD and Macomb Counties state approved CTE Programs instructor completes and signs the course submission form, certifying that the student has completed all outcomes to the required level.
- 3. The Macomb ISD and Macomb Counties state approved CTE Programs instructor provides the course submission form to the Guidance Counselor. The Guidance Counselor will send or fax the form to the Registrar at Davenport University.
- 4. These articulated courses will be treated as transfer courses and thus will not affect the student's GPA at Davenport University.

### Conditions of Agreement

- 1. Davenport University will furnish the list of course outcomes for each course on the equivalency list. This list will be used to certify the student's achievement of outcomes for course articulation.
- 2. Macomb ISD and Macomb Counties state approved CTE Programs and Davenport University will review the list of equivalent courses and their outcomes annually.

Changes will be made to the course outcomes and to the list of equivalent courses as necessary based on changes in courses offered.

- 3. Macomb ISD and Macomb Counties state approved CTE Programs and Davenport University will cooperate in publicizing this program to secondary school students in order to ensure that they are aware of these opportunities.
- 4. Davenport University will not charge tuition for any courses for which a student receives articulated credit.
- 5. The list of equivalent courses will be attached as an appendix to the articulation agreement.
- 6. This agreement, the program of study forms, GAP analysis, and instructional delivery segments will be found at the local schools and Macomb Intermediate School District website, as well as ctenavigator.org.
- 7. Davenport University will furnish an annual summary of students and credits articulated through Macomb ISD and Macomb Counties state approved CTE Programs.

This agreement becomes effective with the beginning of the 2012-2013 academic year and will remain in force for 3 years. This agreement may be terminated at any time by either Macomb ISD and Macomb Counties state approved CTE Programs or Davenport University through providing ninety (90) days' notice. In the event of a termination, both schools agree that students who are currently in secondary program and working toward fulfilling the outcomes or who are in their first semester at Davenport University will be allowed to complete the articulated credit.
